Splitting	Very effective with length up to 50 cm, greater lengths only with well splittable timber.
Hitting	Big hitting area, suitable for felling tasks and splitting as well as driving in weak poles.
Durability	Very good quality and workmanship of the materials used.
Safety	Multiple securing of the handle. GS – testing by VAP Remscheid (Certificate no.: 502278 – 4076 – 50523 - 2010)
